Native of Detroit Michigan and graduate of North Carolina Central University that lives in Brentwood today with his wife Valerie and three boys.



Harvard & MIT (MD, magna cum laude); PhD (laser physics), is a world-renowned laser eye surgeon, philanthropist, and a co-founder of the non-profit Common Ground Network.

Born in China, escaped China's Cultural Revolution – during which millions of innocent youth were deported to remote areas to face a life sentence of hard labor and poverty. He came to America with only \$50 and earned two doctorate degrees, graduated with the highest honors from Harvard Medical School and MIT.

Inventor of the **amniotic membrane contact lens** one of two U.S. patents, has been used by tens of thousands of eye doctors throughout the world in nearly every nation, and millions have had their eyesight restored.

His foundation has helped patients from over 40 states in the U.S. and 55 countries, with all sight restoration surgeries performed free-of-charge. Named Kiwanis **Nashvillian of the Year** for his lifelong dedication to help people in need.
